Red Bull Announces 'Driver Search' Legal Instruments

New York, NY (08 October 2002)—Organizers of the Red Bull F1 Driver Search initiative announced that the candidates will be signing two different agreements surrounding their involvement in the program.

A newly crafted agreement covers only the testing process next week in France. Following the run-off, a separate, different agreement will be executed for the four chosen winners. Program Manager Danny Sullivan said, "The 'test days' contract covers the run-off process only. Then, after we've chosen the four winners, they will be offered – that is a key legal term, by the way – a drive in a European series. And that contract will also be a negotiable instrument. Which series the winning drivers end up in will, of course, be determined in part by the drivers themselves."

The Red Bull F1 Driver Search run-off is October 14 through October 18 at Circuit Paul Ricard in Southern France, where four of the 14 candidates will be chosen as most likely to succeed in European F1 steppingstone series.
